

The Ten Commandments in the Old Testament

- 1. Exo 20:3** Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
- 2. Exo 20:4** Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of *any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth: **Exo 20:5** Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me; **Exo 20:6** And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- 3. Exo 20:7** Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- 4. Exo 20:8** Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. **Exo 20:9** Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: **Exo 20:10** But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: **Exo 20:11** For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD

blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

- 5. Exo 20:12** Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- 6. Exo 20:13** Thou shalt not kill.
- 7. Exo 20:14** Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 8. Exo 20:15** Thou shalt not steal.
- 9. Exo 20:16** Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- 10. Exo 20:17** Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

The Ten Commandments in the New Testament

- 1. Mat 4:10** ...Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- 2. 1Jn 5:21** Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.
- 3. 1Ti 6:1** ...that the name of God and *his* doctrine be not blasphemed.
- 4. Heb 4:4** For he spake in a certain place of the seventh *day* on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works. **Heb 4:5** And in this *place* again, If they shall enter into my

rest. **Heb 4:6** Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief: **Heb 4:7** Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts. **Heb 4:8** For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day. **Heb 4:9** There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.

- 5. Mat 19:19** Honour thy father and *thy* mother:...
- 6. Mat 19:18** ...Thou shalt do no murder...
- 7. Mat 19:18** ...Thou shalt not commit adultery,...
- 8. Mat 19:18** ...Thou shalt not steal,...
- 9. Mat 19:18** ...Thou shalt not bear false witness,
- 10. Rom 13:9** ...Thou shalt not covet;

The Ten Commandments are still valid

Mat 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
Joh 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
1Jn 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

The Ten Commandments in both Testaments

Many people are under the impression that the Ten Commandments are no longer valid. On this pamphlet you will find the 10 Commandments as printed in the Old Testament. I have also included the same 10 commandments as printed in the New Testament. On the website, I've included at least 2 different locations for each of the 10 commandments in the New Testament. Many, if not all of the 10 commandments are written more than twice in the New Testament, but I didn't feel the need to copy more than two instances of each. This pamphlet also has a list of some verses which tell us that the 10 Commandments given by God are indeed still in force.

There is much confusion in today's world about what law, if any, was done away with by the sacrifice of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. This is a vital issue facing anyone who is seeking everlasting life. It is an issue in which satan has clouded the waters substantially, just as the Bible told us he would. *Rev 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.*


